

## **Start thinking about projects**

10 pages, typed, with standard margins, not-too-big font, not-too-wide inter-line spacing.

Bibliography!

It may be risky to use only on-line sources. At the very least, a critical appraisal of your sources is important!

List of possible topics on-line.

Many other possibilities exist, obviously, but the stuff on-line is what I thought of.

Projects are not expected to be original research, but rather competent scholarly reports.

Projects can be mathematical, computational, historical, political, biographical.

Not necessarily closely connected to the course material.

Group projects are fine, but the project should be commensurately bigger and/or better.

I will not attempt to prohibit you from using projects created by you for other courses, but you may need to get permission from the other instructor, and it would be nice if you adapted the project somewhat to be read by me.

You **must** give proper credit to your sources, and must **not** use materials whose use requires a special license. This includes both graphics and text.
