3. **Three** letters of recommendation. These should be from persons familiar with your academic and professional accomplishments, especially of a mathematical nature. The best source for these recommendations is the teachers from your most advanced math courses, who can comment on your interest and potential in math. We prefer that you do not send hardcopy letters of recommendation. 4. A statement of your personal goals and interests, go to <http://www.math.umn.edu/grad/requirements.html>.
5. A copy of your official GRE Math Subject Test score.
6. A copy of your official TOEFL score (for non-native English speaking applicants).
