2. Consider the weighted voting system [10: 12, 5, 4]. Which player is the dictator?

Player 1 (or $P_{1}$ ) can pass a motion without any of the other players. The other players can't pass a motion without $P_{1}$, either. So $P_{1}$ is the dictator.
3. Consider $[12: 9,4,2,1]$. Which player has veto power?

No motion can pass without $P_{1}$ 's 9 votes. Therefore $P_{1}$ has veto power.
4. Consider $[10: 3,2,1]$. Is this a valid weighted voting system? Why or why not?

There are $3+2+1=6$ votes total, which is less than the quota. Therefore this is not a valid system.
